

Checklist for PILGRIM / YATRA Visa

N.B. A pilgrim visa is issued to those who wish to visit the holy places (shrines/Gurdawaras) in Pakistan. It is allowed to group of pilgrims and is normally restricted for a specific period. The pilgrim visa is essentially for single entry. No other type of visa can be combined with pilgrim visa. Two months notice is needed for such applications. Following are the pre-requisites for this visa.

2	Two passport sized photos (White Background)		
3	Original passport valid for six months at least (Along with copy)		
4	UK valid residence visa with its copy (if applicable)		
5	Invitation letter from the sponsor in Pakistan and their ID with complete address. In case of Group, an introductory letter and complete documentation will be needed by the organizing body/ tour operator etc. In UK and Pakistan.		
6	Proof of Address e.g. Utility bill, Council tax bill, rental agreement or UK driving licence.		
7	Latest one month's bank statement.		
8	Work reference letter from the work place indicating that you are currently in their employment. Those who are not in employment will provide copy of benefit letter, any letter from job centre or Pension letter etc as the case may be.		
9	Itinerary, accommodation arrangement and schedule of visit.
